The following guidelines have been framed for the course credits of the students who take up the online courses to be approved by the Academic Council in March 2018.

- It was discussed that the respective chairpersons can consider bring in online courses in order to have them in the place of open electives / professional electives
- It was decided that the respective chairpersons will decide the list of courses along with the appropriate online platforms to be approved so that the policy across all the boards is uniform
- It was mentioned that online courses up to 20% can be brought in for PG programmes as well in order to make it more appealing for the PG students
- The Heads of the Departments were requested to motivate the student's right from the first year for online certification and particularly expose them to certifications in big data, Machines Learning and AI to get into jobs in 2018
