

Rules for offering NPTEL Courses as an alternate Program Electives with transfer of Credit.

- NTR.1. These rules shall be applicable from Academic Year 2018-2019. They are prepared as per the Extraordinary Gazette, Part III – Section 4 Notification No. 332 dated August 22, 2016 and Curriculum Development Board, BIRLA VISHVAKARMA MAHAVIDYALAYA minutes of meeting point number CDB1718.3.4.
- NTR.2. The NPTEL courses decided by the respective Board of Studies (BoS) shall be of advanced or recent topics. They should not have similar or overlapping contents vis-a-vis the core subjects offered by the respective BoS.
- NTR.3. Each BoS, for its UG program, shall approve a list of around 5 to 15 (number as per their suitability) NPTEL subjects of 8 week and 12 week duration. These subjects shall be offered as an alternate to program electives of the respective branch offered in any semester from 5 to 8.
- NTR.4. NPTEL Certifications of an 8 weeks course will be considered equivalent to a 3 or 4 credit elective, for awarding exemption.
- NTR.5. NPTEL Certifications of a 12 weeks course will be considered equivalent to a 5 or 6 credit elective, for awarding exemption.
- NTR.6. NPTEL Certifications of two separate 8 weeks course will be considered equivalent to 5 or 6 credit elective, for awarding exemption.
- NTR.7. NPTEL courses are not valid alternative to Open Elective.
- NTR.8. NPTEL Certifications of any 4 weeks course will not be considered for credit transfer.
- NTR.9. Students can register and give exam for these NPTEL courses in any semester from 5 to 8.
- NTR.10. NPTEL course result will be valid for two years, for credit transfer against any program elective.
- NTR.11. The registration of NPTEL courses shall be approved by the faculty counselor and Head of the Department.
- NTR.12. The conversion from percentage marks given by NPTEL to the corresponding grades shall be as follows:
