

## VRSEC MOOCs REGULATIONS FOR VR17 BATCH

5. The following provision is approved by the Academic Council and it comes into force w.e.f. 2017-18.

### SELF LEARNING COURSES: MOOCs certification

The self-learning courses shall be taken from the list of approved MOOCs providers. They must be approved in the respective Board of Studies. The courses under this category shall carry two credits.

Students who have qualified in the examination conducted by the above providers are exempted from appearing in the internal and semester end examinations conducted by the institution.

In case a student fails to complete the MOOCs course offered by external providers, he/she may be allowed to register again for the same with any of the providers from the list provided by the department or the student may be allowed to register for the self-learning course as and when offered by the college as supplementary candidate.

### 7.2.5 Independent Learning

The students can learn the courses offered under this category on their own. The courses offered under this category include:

#### Self-Learning Courses

One self-learning course offered in V Semester and any one elective course in VII / VIII Semester.

The self-learning courses will be recommended by the department from the available open courseware. The self-learning courses shall be taken from the list of approved MOOCs providers (SWAYAM / NPTEL/ EDX / Others). They must be approved in the respective Board of Studies.

### **9.2.5 Self-Learning Courses (Prescribed from the existing open courseware)**

Students who have qualified in the examination conducted by the MOOC providers as specified in 7.2.5 are exempted from appearing in the continuous and semester end evaluations conducted by the institution.

In case a student fails to complete the MOOCs course offered by MOOC's providers, he/she may be allowed to register again for the same with any of the providers from the list provided by the department or the student may be allowed to register for the self-learning course as and when offered by the college as supplementary candidate.

For the courses under this category, those students who have not registered under MOOCs platform and are able to learn by themselves shall appear for continuous evaluation for 30 marks and semester end examination for 70 marks.
