### Minutes:

Prof. Bhaskar Ramamurthi, Chairman, CSS-MOOCs PIC and Director, IIT Madras, welcomed the committee members who were present and thanked them for attending the meeting.

Prof. Andrew Thangaraj, Coordinator, IIT Madras briefed everyone about the activities carried out under the CSS-MOOCs project – between April to December 2016.

- 104 courses were offered between July-October 2016.
- Institutes that participated: 7 IITs, IISc, IIT Patna, CMI, IIITH, IIITD and NIE
- Exams were conducted for the courses on 18 and 25 September and 16 and 23 October for 73 and 31 courses for which 23176 and 8268 candidates were registered respectively
- Over the past 11 runs, the average attendance has been 80% while the average pass percentage has been 70%.
- It was found that in the last 3 exam runs, the number of girls registering for the exam is more than that of boys while the average exam registration for faculty has been about 12%.
- NPTEL online courses are being used for credit transfer in a few colleges, for applying to companies/ IITs for internship opportunities, etc.
